



Talking Points



- Began in 2003 by students at River City Christian School and became an official Fiesta® event in 2006, created for individuals with disabilities.
- Fiesta Especial® is a family-friendly, alcohol and tobacco free event that the whole family can enjoy.
- The 2013 Fiesta Especial® Royal Court is made up of 9 individuals with disabilities, ages 2-18, representing 5 different disability service organizations. Together, they collected over \$16,600 for programs and services benefitting children and adults with disabilities through their campaigns. The Coronation for the court takes place on Sat. Feb. 16th from 5-7p at Morgan's Wonderland.
- In 2013, Fiesta Especial® returns to the traditional carnival rides we've had in the past.
- \$5 General Admission. Tickets for food, rides and games are sold separately.
- Benefits children and adults with disabilities throughout our community
- Over 2,500 children from special education classes will attend for free on Fri, April 19th due to generous sponsorships from our community. Sponsorships are still needed.
- Shoebox Float Parade on Friday, April 19th. Deadline to enter is April 12th.
- Fiesta Especial® Promenade and Parade on Saturday, April 20th. Parade will highlight organizations that serve individuals with disabilities. Parade begins at 9:00am.
- Promenade and Parade kicks off with a 2.7 Mile Fun Run/Walk at 8:15am. Registration is \$10 and includes complimentary general admission to the event following the parade.
- A set of 4 tickets and 2 Fiesta Especial® medals will be given away to one lucky individual who "Likes" our facebook page before 5pm that day.
